DSIR invites proposals for Creation of Resource Centres on Technology and Innovation Management and to initiate activities under it.

The Technology Management (TM) Programme of the DSIR works in close association with industry, industry associations, research organizations, academic institutes, consultants and others. towards the objectives of enhancing capabilities in management of technology, innovation and technology transfer in the country. Under this programme, multifarious activities are supported. One of the major focus areas has been creation of Resource Centres on Technology and Innovation Management that undertake activities such as sector-specific diagnostic studies needing technological interventions (technology management needs), research studies on TM issues, skill development and training programmes to suit the capacity building needs of specific-sectors of the region of concern after identification of the needs of the particular region, etc. During Phase-I, it is proposed to create Resource Centres on Technology and Innovation Management in the States of North-East, West Bengal, Orissa, Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh and Maharashtra to carry out the following activities:

- i) Diagnostic studies in sectors/products needing technological interventions (Technology Management needs) in the particular region of concern, for enhancing industrial competitiveness and entrepreneurship development, with special reference to MSMEs.
- ii) Awareness programmes on Technology & Innovation Management issues.
- iii) Entrepreneurship development programme in the above identified industrial sectors.
- iv) Skill development and knowledge enhancement training programmes for potential upcoming and existing entrepreneurs.
- v) Intensive capacity building training programmes for each identified sector prioritized on the basis of the needs of the region of concern.
- vi) Any other activity relevant to Technology and Innovation Management for capability building.

Who can submit the proposals ?

Industry and industry associations, consultancy organizations, academic institutes, State and Central Government bodies/agencies including autonomous bodies and any other agency/organization of repute having experience and expertise in carrying out above referred activities.
