### **Summary Report**

This report is based on a 4-day Indian Technology & Trade Fair held at Durban. About 20 District Industries Centres were associated with the Technology Trade Fair to motivate exporting units and units having export potential to participate in this trade fair to explore the export market for their products. In all 53 units participated in the Technology Trade Fair. This fair estimated to have generated export order of Rs. 10 crore through trade enquiries. A sum of Rs. 2.60 lakh was received by sales proceeds. In all 20,000 visitors visited the trade fairs. Visitors showed their keen interest in Indian technology specially in software, leather and leather products such as saddlery, shoes, belting, etc., handicrafts including brassware, chicken work and wooden crafts.

The UP Industrial Consultants Ltd. (UPICO) in collaboration with UP Trade Promotion Authority (UPTPA) is planning to organize international trade fair in different countries in order to boost exports form India to most-favoured countries. They have plan to organise three new trade fairs in Mauritius, Los Angeles, and Australia, and repeat fairs in China and Sourth Africa. Earlier a fair was organised at Najing, China, 30 November-4 December 2001.
