Partial financial support would be providedas grant-in-aid for procuring R&D equipment and accessories and setting up of pilot plant facilities for prototype developmentto facilitate MSMEs to undertake R&D and technology development fornew/improved products and processes including testing and analysis.

Proposals are invited from National laboratories, Public funded bodies or Institutions having a distinct legal entity (as per Rule 228 of GFR 2017) for setting up of CRTDHs in the following five sectors:

- 1. Electronics/Renewable Energy
- 2. Affordable Health
- 3. Environmental Interventions
- 4. Low Cost Machining
- 5. New Materials / Chemical Process
