**First Appellate Authority  
Under RTI Act, 2005**

Date of Hearing and Date of Decision: -18<sup>th</sup> March, 2021 at 1030 Hrs.

The appellant was available via video call. DSIR was represented by Dr. Anoop Singh, Scientist-D (respondent1) and Dr. Suman Mazumdar, acting CPIO were present during the appeal.

2. The appellate authority noted that the appellant was not satisfied with the reply & documentary evidence provided to him by the department against his RTI application No. DOSIR/R/E/20/00062 dated 20.01.2021. Therefore, the appellant in his appeal registration No. DOSIR/A/E/21/00001 dated 23.02.2021 has asked for clarifications and further documentary evidence which was assumed to have been omitted as sought by him in his RTI application No. DOSIR/R/E/20/00062 dated 20.01.2021.

3. The appellate authority could speak to appellant via video call. Appellate authority perused RTI application and noted that the appellant has sought complete file along with file note sheets comprising of 1539 pages in his RTI application. Appellant has also made a payment for receiving these copies.

4. Appellate Authority informed appellant that the information as sought in Point 1-3 in the RTI appeal is a misunderstanding. Since TAC reviews several projects in each meeting, thus the pages of agenda, updated agenda & minutes related to particular projects are only placed in the respective files and not the full copy of the agenda/updated agenda/minutes. Thus no information/pages were concealed.

5. Appellate Authority informed appellant that the information as sought in Point 4 of the RTI appeal has already been provided by the program division which includes TAC recommended head wise break-up of support mentioned in the minutes etc. as contained in the project file and that nothing has been concealed.

6. Appellate authority further discussed about any further information to be provided by the DSIR to appellant, with no further queries, the above appeal stands disposed off.
