Text of RTI First Appeal :	<p>It is submitted that that the PIO has stated that the information which are exempted from disclosure under Section 8 (d)of RTI Act, In this connection it is informed that information enumerated in Clauses (d), get only conditional exemption that is the exemption is subject to the overriding power of the competent authority under the RTI Act in larger public interest to direct disclosure of such information. The information relating to intellectual property and the information available to persons in their fiduciary relationship referred to in Clauses (d) of Section 8 do not enjoy absolute exemption. It is needless to say that the competent authority will have to record reasons for holding that an exempted information should be disclosed in the larger public interest but no such reasons have been supplied to the applicant. It is further submitted in catena of decisions, which are similar to this case it has been held that Cabinet papers, including records of deliberations of the Council of Ministers, Secretaries and other offices, are excluded, but once a decision is made, the reasons for the decisions and the documents which were used to make the decision should then be disclosed to the public. This is important because it means that during the decision-making process there is a level of confidentiality, but once a decision is made the public has a right to access relevant information so that they can better understand the policy-making process. In the said case decisions have already been taken in the minutes of proceedings. Kind attention is also drawn to the decision No. CIC/SG/A/2012/001023/19365 in Appeal No . CIC/SG/A/2012/001023 in case of Venkatesh Nayak New Delhi- V/S PIO & OSD(ER) Department of Atomic Energy, which is also relevant in the matter and applicable to this case. In addition to this, the information sought for, is of general nature and is not specific to any company</p>
